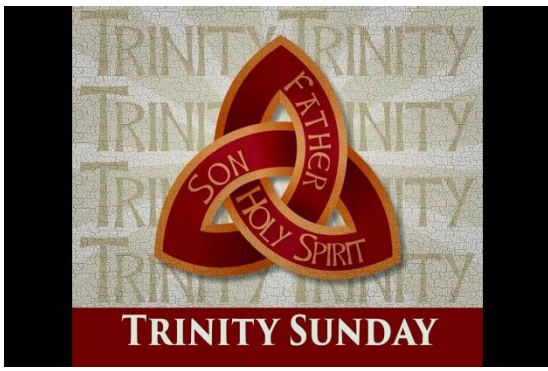

Parish Walk 8.5 miles

This is an interesting trail route exploring the local landscape combination of nature and industry. There are several options for those wanting a shorter route.

Route: Along Sough Tunnel to Whittlestone Head following the railway trail towards Entwistle. Cross the railway bridge and up the old tramline route to Roman Road. Explore Roundbarn Quarry with time for a brew and break. Traverse the top of the quarry and on to the Naze for lunch at the old Broadhead Colliery coke kilns. After lunch follow the trails to Aushaw and back down to Roman Rd., crossing over and following the path opposite the Crown & Thistle to Top of the Meadow. Follow the main path around Cranberry Moss to the coke kiln near Bull Hill. Back to Blacksnape via Jacks Key and Cranberry.

There are mainly good trail paths with some moorland sections. Please bring water/packed lunch. We will have a brew/snack break and lunch. Depending on the group and length of stops we will be back 3-4pm.

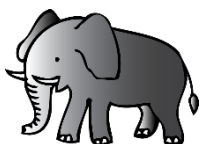
